Dr. Stefan Demmerle was appointed Vice President, President and General Manager of BorgWarner Battery Energy Systems and Chief Technology Officer in July 2026. In this role, Demmerle is responsible for BorgWarner's global Battery Energy Systems business and leading BorgWarner's global technology strategy and innovation.

Prior to his current role, Demmerle was President and General Manager of BorgWarner PowerDrive Systems and BorgWarner TorqTransfer Systems.

Before joining BorgWarner in 2012, Demmerle was Vice President of the powertrain electronics business at Continental from 2010 to 2012 after leading Continental Diesel Systems (formerly known as Siemens Diesel Systems Technology) as President and CEO from 2006 to 2010. He previously held positions of increasing responsibility within Siemens VDO Automotive in the transmission and engine electronics businesses both in France and worldwide. He began his career in France with assignments in sales and program management for automotive engine components.

Demmerle holds a master's degree in mechanical engineering from the Technical University of Munich, Germany, as well as a doctorate in mechanical engineering from the Institut Polytechnique de Grenoble, France.

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
