

BorgWarner remporte un nouveau contrat pour moteurs électriques avec un grand constructeur automobile chinois

- *Conception basée sur une plateforme, compatible avec tous les types de véhicules à énergies nouvelles (NEV)*
- *Procédé de soudage ultra-court améliorant l'efficacité de l'espace*
- *Nouvelle usine à Wuhu bientôt opérationnelle, augmentation des capacités de production en Chine*

Auburn Hills, Michigan, 31 juillet 2025 – BorgWarner a décroché un nouveau contrat avec un important constructeur automobile chinois pour la fourniture de moteurs électriques, marquant une avancée majeure sur le marché chinois des véhicules à énergies nouvelles (NEV). Le moteur retenu repose sur une conception modulaire, compatible avec l'ensemble des applications NEV, y compris les véhicules 100 % électriques et hybrides. Il intègre également le procédé innovant de soudage à épingles courtes (« ultra-short hairpin welding ») développé par BorgWarner, qui réduit la hauteur des extrémités de bobinage. Résultat : une structure plus compacte et une utilisation optimisée de l'espace.

« Nous sommes très satisfaits des progrès continus de notre activité moteurs électriques en Chine. Notre partenariat avec ce client dure depuis près de dix ans », a déclaré le Dr Stefan Demmerle, vice-président de BorgWarner Inc. et président-directeur général de PowerDrive Systems. « BorgWarner reste pleinement engagé à fournir des solutions moteur toujours plus intelligentes et efficaces, pour construire ensemble un avenir électrifié. »

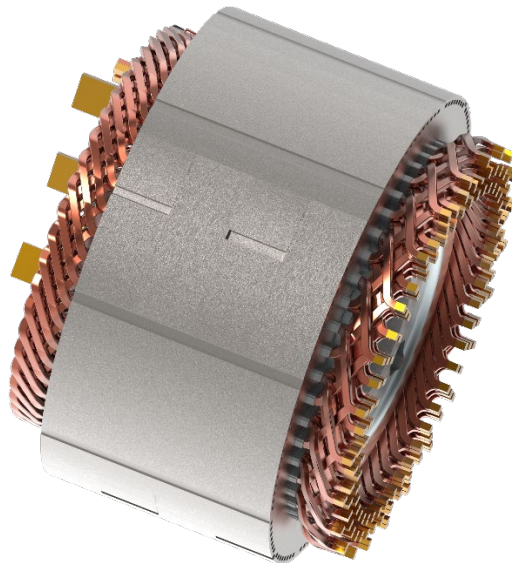

Début 2025, BorgWarner a signé un protocole d'accord avec la municipalité de Wuhu pour établir un nouveau site de production dédié aux systèmes de propulsion électrique. Cette nouvelle usine, actuellement en phase finale de préparation, sera équipée de lignes de

production intelligentes capables de fabriquer plusieurs types de moteurs sur des lignes partagées. Elle permettra d'augmenter considérablement la capacité de production et de poser les bases d'une montée en cadence à grande échelle.
