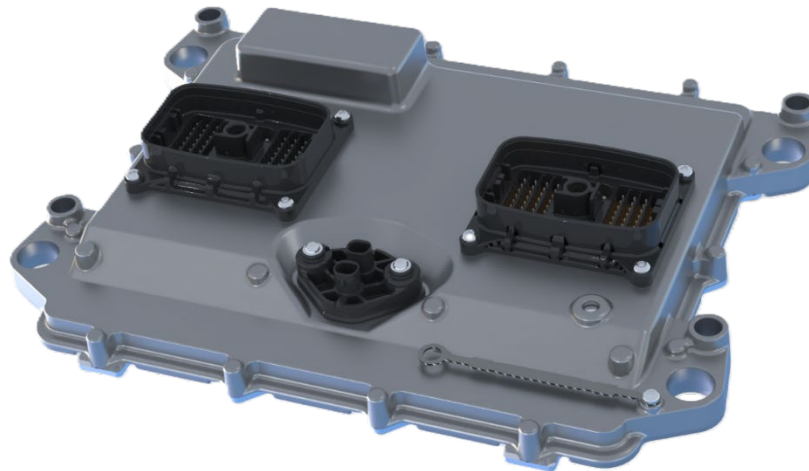
Auburn Hills, Michigan, 28. April 2026 – BorgWarner hat eine Vertragsverlängerung über sieben Jahre vereinbart, um acht Gruppen von Motor-, Maschinen-, Leistungsmodul- und Batteriemanagementsystem-Controllern an einen weltführenden Off-Highway-Hersteller zu liefern. Die neu vereinbarte Laufzeit erstreckt sich bis Dezember 2032. Die Verlängerung baut auf einer jahrzehntelangen Partnerschaft mit dem OEM auf und deckt ein breites Anwendungsspektrum ab – von Baufahrzeugen, Marineapplikationen bis hin zu stationären Energiesystemen.
