

BorgWarner prolonge son activité de contrôleurs avec un fabricant mondial de premier plan d'engins hors route

- *Contrat couvrant huit familles de contrôleurs pour applications moteur, module de puissance et gestion de batterie*

- *Partenariat ancré dans plusieurs décennies de collaboration*

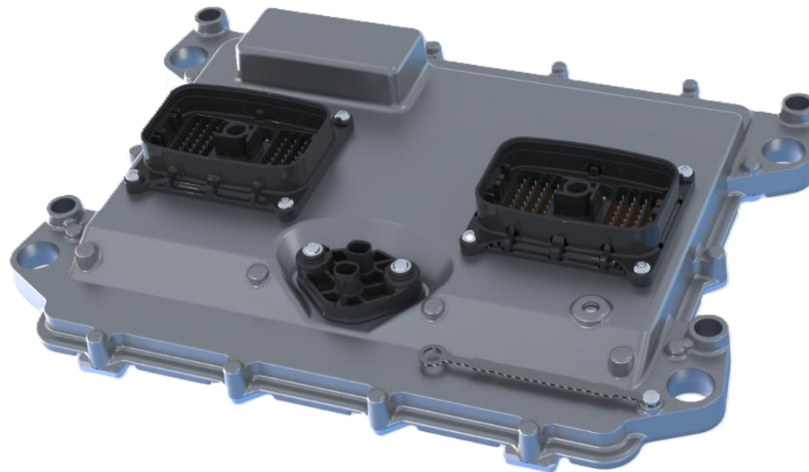
Auburn Hills, Michigan, 28 avril 2026 – BorgWarner a obtenu une prolongation de contrat de sept ans pour la fourniture de huit familles de contrôleurs moteur, machine, module de puissance et système de gestion de batterie à un fabricant mondial leader dans le secteur off-highway. Le nouveau contrat court jusqu'en décembre 2032. Cette prolongation s'inscrit dans le cadre d'un partenariat de longue date avec le fabricant, couvrant un large spectre d'applications allant des engins de construction et des applications marines aux systèmes d'énergie stationnaires.

« BorgWarner entretient un partenariat de confiance avec ce fabricant off-highway de premier plan, que nous approvisionnons en composants sensibles depuis plusieurs décennies.
